Become the Community Resource Specialist at our newest veterans housing communities in Virginia Beach and Chesapeake (the latter location will open in the Summer of 2019).

To be successful in this role, you need to understand the importance of gifts based assessment. It's not really about vets deficits, but rather about what they do have in their in their personal toolkit. Helping them identify, strengthen and market these gifts will increase their independence and enhancing their quality of life. Reconnecting them with important VA and community resources is also important.

Responsibilities

- Assessment, monitoring and case management
- Individual counseling and crisis intervention
- On-call for overnight/weekend emergencies on a rotating basis
- Collaborate with service provider agencies to build relationships and ensure timely communications
- Plan, organize and instruct specific classes, activities and events; some of which will be during evening or weekends
- Responsible for transporting veterans using company vehicle, on occasion

Minimum Professional Requirements

- Bachelor's degree in social work;
- Minimum of 1-2 years working in a social service agency;
- You must currently be or most recently have been in a job with a title relevant to professional level social work /case management;
- Must be able to communicate and connect with a diverse group of people;
- Must be in personal alignment with VBCDC's corporate vision, mission and values;
- Must be able to work independently (with offsite supervision) and be accountable for time and deliverables;



- Must have excellent organization, innovation and customer service skills;
- Mastery level knowledge of Microsoft Office Suite; and
- Demonstrated ability to build internal and external alliances.

Physical Demands/Work Environment

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is frequently required to sit, talk, see, or hear. The employee is also frequently required to stand and walk. The employee must occasionally lift and/or move up to 20 pounds. The employee must have a valid driver's license, own an automobile which can be used for occasional travel during the work day, and carry at least \$300,000 of liability car insurance. Employee must be available for travel in Virginia Beach and Chesapeake during the workweek and occasional work hours that may include evenings and weekends.

Employee will frequently be asked to work a non-traditional daily schedule. The employee may work 10AM-7PM , including one hour for lunch (offered only as an example).
